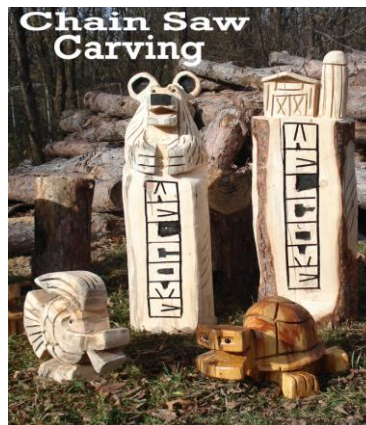
Fischer Family's All-American Lumberjack Show Officially Coming to Town!
